Explanation of Terms:

- MSDS – Material Safety Data Sheet – This should be provided by the supplier of the material
- Workplace Exposure Limit (WEL) - Legal limits that have been set on the amounts of many of the substances that can be present in workplace air. See HSE booklet EH40 (Download off the HSE website)
- LTEL – Long Term Exposure Limit
- STEL – Short Term Exposure Limit (up to a maximum of 15 minutes)
- Hazardous Statement - Means a phrase assigned to a hazard class and category that describes the nature of the hazards of a hazardous substance or mixture, including, where appropriate, the degree of hazard
- Hazardous Properties (Waste) – These are the codes required for when disposing of the material as hazardous waste
- PPE – Personal Protective Equipment
- LEV – Local Exhaust Vent (e.g. extractor hood)
